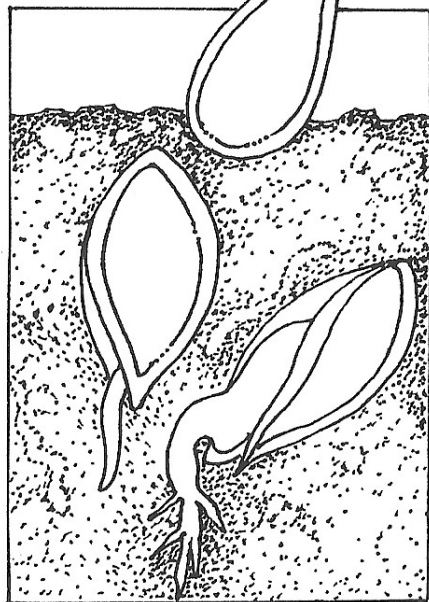
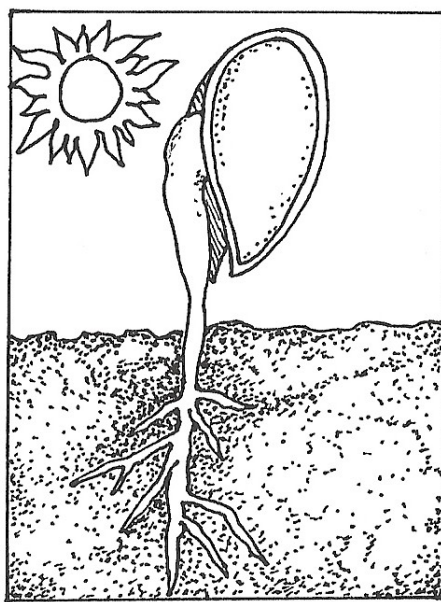


# HOW PUMPKINS GROW

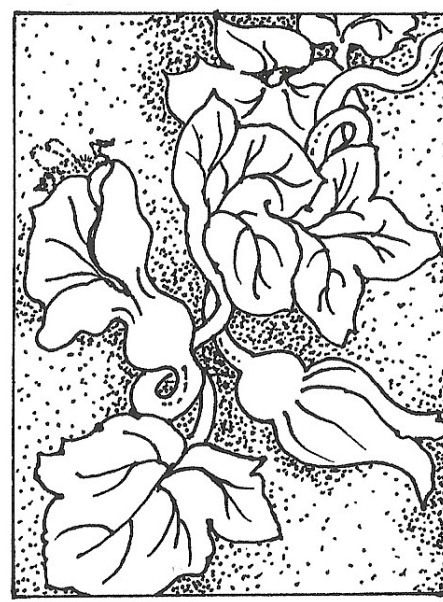
A SIEMERS' FARM SCIENCE PROJECT



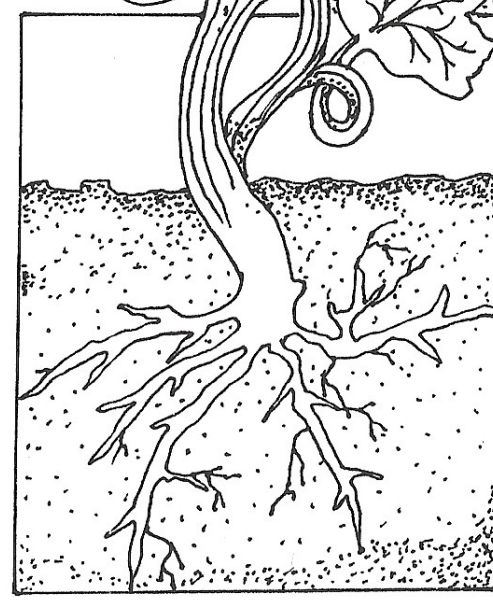
Plant seeds ½" deep in well-drained, warm soil.



The warm sun and moisture cause the seed to sprout and grow.



Pumpkins are flowers first. Bees help pollinate the flowers.



Pumpkin plants grow long vines. Pumpkins should be picked before it freezes.

**Discussion Questions :** What is the same about the way that pumpkins grow and the way that apples grow?

**Answer:** The blossoms of both plants need to be pollinated. Can you find the hidden worms and the bee in the pictures?
